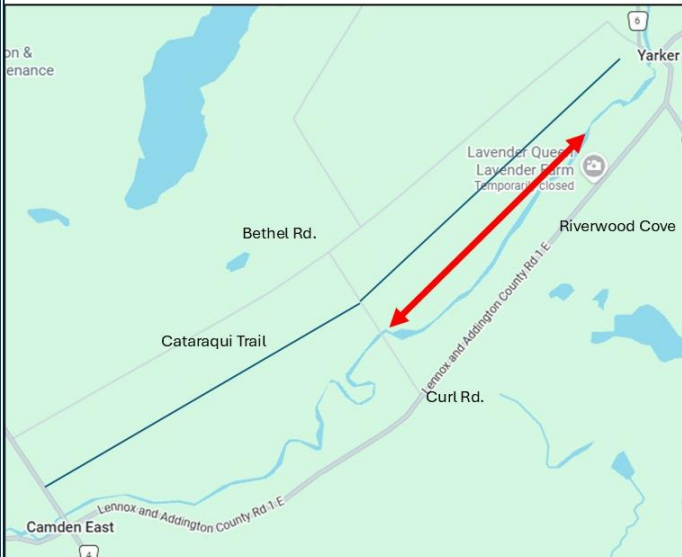


PUBLIC NOTICE

Flowering Rush control project area, July 2026



NOTICE: An aquatic herbicide application for the control of Flowering Rush (*butomus umbellatus*) is planned during the month of July on the Napanee River between Yarker and Camden East and adjacent private properties.

The following **river shoreline** locations will be treated and signage will be posted throughout the following areas at water access points:

Northside of the river shoreline between
174 – 696 Cutler Road,
Northside of the river shoreline between
586 – 428 Bethel Road,
Southside of the river shoreline between
3623 – 4043 County Road 1E, and
Residents along Curl Road.

Residents within 1 km downriver of the project area should visit www.FriendsNapaneeRiver.ca for regular updates on the herbicide application and recommended precautions.

Anticipated Start Dates: July 27th-28th, 2026 (weather permitting)

Herbicide: Habitat Aqua (active ingredient: imazapyr), PMRA Reg. no. 32374

There is NO RESTRICTION on the use of water for recreation or domestic purposes (i.e. toilets, showers, drinking). As a precautionary measure, all residences using a surface water system for consumption (for example: taking water **DIRECTLY** from the waterway to drink, cook or for food preparations) should shut down their water system and avoid consumption of the water for a minimum of 48 hours following herbicide application. Systems should be flushed for at least 20 minutes before consuming again. Please note: These precautionary measures are only for those with private water systems drawing water **DIRECTLY** from the waterway.
